Keith Shapley

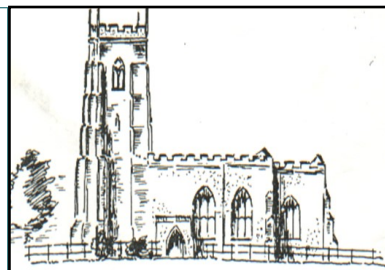
