Defibrillator Awareness

In conjunction with the NHS, Chilton Parish Council has recently installed the defibrillator by the entrance of the Sudbury Health Centre for the benefit of anyone living within a 1 mile radius of the Health Centre. This means that most Chilton residents will be directed to the defibrillator by the Ambulance Service should the need arise.

No training is necessary for you to operate the defibrillator, but should you want to understand how it works Chilton Parish Council has arranged for Community Heartbeat Trust to give an Awareness session to residents on Monday 3rd April 2017 starting at 7.30pm in Great Waldingfield Village Hall. The Awareness session will be followed by Chilton's Annual Parish Assembly.

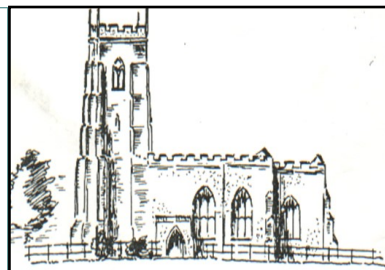

CHILTON WOODS

It is now a year since the planning application for Chilton Woods was first circulated and commented upon by the community and Chilton Parish Council. There were a number of issues that were referred back to Suffolk County Council, as the applicant, and to date there has not been any communication by either Babergh District Council or Suffolk County Council on the subject.

The planning application is still live and you will be kept updated on its progress as soon as CPC is consulted.

SUDBURY GREEN BELT

The Sudbury Green Belt information campaign is now under way, with a meeting on Tuesday 25th April 2017 at 7.15pm at St Peters Church, Sudbury. This will be a chance to question candidates for the County Council elections and hear about choices for our area. The campaign believes that green spaces round Sudbury, Chilton and Cornard can and should be protected from sprawling development.

Meanwhile, Local Wildlife and Environment groups will next be manning the Green Stall at the Crafts and Gifts Sale in St Peters Church, Market Hill on Saturday 22nd April 2017 10am to 4pm.
